Lynn Rozental named Assistant Director, Development & Communications of The Textile Museum

November 8, 2006, Washington, DC — The Board of Trustees of The Textile Museum and Director Daniel Walker are pleased to announce the appointment of Lynn Rozental to Assistant Director, Development & Communications. Rozental comes to The Textile Museum from Inova Health System Foundation, Virginia, where she served as Director of Development, Nursing. Rozental assumed her position on November 8, 2006.

“All of the Trustees and staff are delighted that Lynn Rozental has joined the Museum. Her record of cultivating, building and managing successful development and communication operations will be an invaluable asset to the Museum,” said Museum Director Daniel Walker. “Rozental will play a key role in the cultivation and stewardship of annual and major gifts to the Museum from individuals, corporations, foundations, members and government grants.”

Lynn Rozental has been with Inova Health System Foundation since 1995, first as Director of Development, Foundation Giving, and most recently as Director of Development, Nursing. Rozental was responsible for planning and managing Inova’s first capital campaign initiative for nursing, which developed and funded major gift opportunities for nursing support.

From 1988 to 1994 Rozental served as Museum Director of The Lyceum in Alexandria, Virginia, where she guided the institution’s transition from a former Bicentennial Center to a community history museum, managing the museum’s scholarly research, exhibitions, publications and public education programs. Prior to that, from 1983 to 1987, Rozental worked in development at the Columbia Pike Revitalization Organization, (CPRO), Virginia.
